Full Recycling of Oil Contaminated Waste

The implementation of various environmental legislation and policies has put greater pressure onto businesses to ensure that hazardous wastes produced are dealt with in the appropriate manner.

New Solvent Recycling Plant at Carryduff Facility

In November of this year, we began operating a new recycling plant at our facility in Carryduff, Co. Down. This plant is the largest and most technically advanced of its type in Northern Ireland, and will produce significant savings for local industry.

The new equipment allows us to take in spray paint mixed with solvent, and utilises distillation as a means of recycling, which provides a clean, safe and cost-effective alternative to the single use and disposal of solvents – prior to this, industry and garages in Northern Ireland had to send the used paint to England.

In addition to the environmental benefits, the recycled solvent can be used by our customers for paint

thinning and also for cleaning, which again significantly reduces cost when compared to buying higher-priced new solvent.

This new facility will be taking used solvent from customers in both Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland. The used solvent will be bulked at Enva Ireland's facilities in Portlaoise, Shannon, Cork and Dublin, prior to being transported to the Carryduff facility.
